The ZDF correspondent and former head of the ZDF studio in Tel Aviv Dr. Nicola Albrecht read single passages from her book "My Israel and I" and told with the help of numerous pictures exciting stories of her intensive encounters with people of different origins and biographies in this diverse, tangled, beautiful and frightening country - along the Road 90. She also reported how it is to live with her family in a crisis area. After the reading she was very interested in the activities of our association. She gave me many contact addresses of journalists from the print media and television correspondents in Tel Aviv and Jerusalem. The chief correspondent of the ARD capital studio in Tel Aviv, Tim Assmann, and the Frankfurter Rundschau editor Inge Günther, for example, showed great interest in providing journalistic support for our trip to Israel-Palestine-Jordan in October.

1.2 EdK action "Between two worlds" in Bergisch-Gladbach on 10.6.22









The artist couple Carmen Dietrich and Gregor Merten had formed two works of art from a metal plate, which stand for Bergisch Gladbach's partnerships in Israel and Palestine. First, the stele with the symbols of the Abrahamic religions was ceremoniously unveiled on Beit-Jala-Platz. The counterpart, an angel, was carried in a parade across the city and now stands in Ganey Tikva Square. More than 200 people, including a large number of kindergarten children and schoolchildren, took part in the event with musical contributions. The art project is intended to support intercultural and interreligious exchange, as a visible sign of the desire for peace, solidarity and preservation of democracy. In cooperation with the city of Bergisch Gladbach, the town twinning association Bergisch Gladbach - Beit Jala e.V. and the town twinning association Ganey Tikva - Bergisch Gladbach, this strong symbol of peace now also came to Bergisch Gladbach, with the project being financed by the Bethe Foundation. 2. current situation in Israel-Palestine + new info about ToN and **Daoud Nassar**

The situation in Israel-Palestine is very unclear in view of the new election of the Knesset on 1.11.22. Even the visit of the US president this week is not likely to change anything. Therefore, it is not surprising that still no court date has been set for the reregistration of the ToN has been set. A total of 28 criminal cases have been initiated for attacks by Palestinian families on the ToN, so that more court dates will follow. Therefore, it will not be known until next week if and when he will be able to come to Germany in September 22. The latest information about his planned tour in Germany will be published on our homepage during the next week. The completely outdated website of the ToN (www.tentofnations.org) should be completely redesigned by September 22 and updated with more detailed information for visitors and volunteers and with contact persons in Germany.
